- **Choose the right contractor.** Look for a licensed and experienced professional who is registered as a participating contractor in the HEATING & COOLING INCENTIVE.

\$400	Have an existing CAC replaced with the purchase and installation of a stand alone CEE Tier 3 level CAC system (SEER 15+)
